Dear Applicant:

This modifies our letter of the above date in which we stated that you would be treated as an organization which is not a private foundation until the expiration of your advance ruling period.

Your exempt status under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) is still in effect. Based on the information you submitted, we have determined that you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the code because you are an organization of the type described in section 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

Grantors and contributors may rely on this determination unless the Internal Revenue Service publishes notice to the contrary. However, if you lose your section 509(a)(1) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for, or was aware of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in your loss of such status, or if he or she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a)(1) organization.

If we have indicated in the heading of this letter that an addendum applies, the addendum enclosed is an integral part of this letter.

Based on information supplied, and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemption, we have determined you are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Because you are a newly created organization, we are not now making a final determination of your foundation status under section 509(a) of the Code. However, we have determined that you can reasonably be expected to be a publicity supported organization described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

Accordingly, you will be treated as a publicly supported organization, and not as a private foundation, during an advance ruling period. This advance ruling period begins on the date of your inception and ends on the date shown above.

Within 90 days after the end of your advance ruling period, you must submit to us information needed to determine whether you have met the requirements of the applicable support test during the advance ruling period. If you establish that you have been a publicly supported organization, you will be classified as a section 509(a)(1) or 509(a)(2) organization as long as you continue to meet the requirements of the applicable support test. If you do not meet the public support requirements during the advance ruling period, you will be classified as a private foundation for future periods. Also, if you are classified as a private foundation, you will be treated as a private foundation from the date of your inception for purposes of sections 507(d) and 4940.

Grantors and contributors may rely on the determination that you are not a private foundation until 90 days after the end of your advance ruling

period. If you submit the required information within the 90 days, grantors and contributors may continue to rely on the advance determination until the Service makes a final determination of your foundation status.

It notice that you will no longer be treated as a publicity supported organization is published in the Internal Revenue Bulletin, grantors and contributors may not rely on this determination after the date of such publication. In addition, if you lose your status as a publicity supported organization and a conscitutor or contributor was responsible for, or was aware of the act or failure conscituted in your loss of such status, that person may not rely on this determination from the date of the act or failure to act. Also, if a grantor or contributor learned that the Service had given notice that you would be removed from classification as a publicity supported organization, then that person may not rely on this determination as of the date such knowledge was acquired.

If your sources of supports or your purposes, characters or method of operation changes please but us know so we can consider the effect of the shange on your exempt status and foundation status. In the case of an amendment to your organizational document or bylaws, please send us a copy of the smooded document or bylaws. Also, you should inform us of all changes in your added and address.

As of January 1, 1964, you are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more as pay to each of your employees during a calendar year. You are not liable to the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Organizations that are now private foundations are not subject to the following taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, you are not automatically exampt from other Federal excise waxes. If you have any questions about extens employment, or other Federal baxes, please let us know.

Conors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the social Requests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use deductible for Federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of sections 2005, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

You are required to file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt from income Tax, only if your gross receipts each year are normally more than 150,000. If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the 15th may of the anoth after the end of your annual accounting period. The law imposes penalty of \$10 a day, up to a maximum of \$5,000, when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay.

You are not required to file Federal income tax returns unless you are subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. It you are subject to this tax, you must file an income tax return on Form Yvo-is Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return. In this letters we are not determining whether say of your present or proposed activities are unre-
