### 2. Fund for the Study of Economic Growth and Tax Reform

The Fund for the Study of Economic Growth and Tax Reform was formed to raise money for a private commission studying the Internal Revenue Code. It was headed by Jack Kemp. The fund applied to the IRS for 501(c)(3) recognition stating it was conducting non-partisan analysis, study and research. The IRS refused the 501(c)(3) recognition stating the Fund was an action organization. As a result the Fund has filed suit in the U.S. District Court in D.C. under section 7428.
